

inViu routes

Retrieving trackables' data from an ENAIKOON account

1 ENAIKOON iD

An ENAIKOON iD is necessary in order to log into *inViu pro* and *inViu web* and retrieve data from trackables. Login credentials include a valid, user-defined E-mail address and a password.

2 Installation

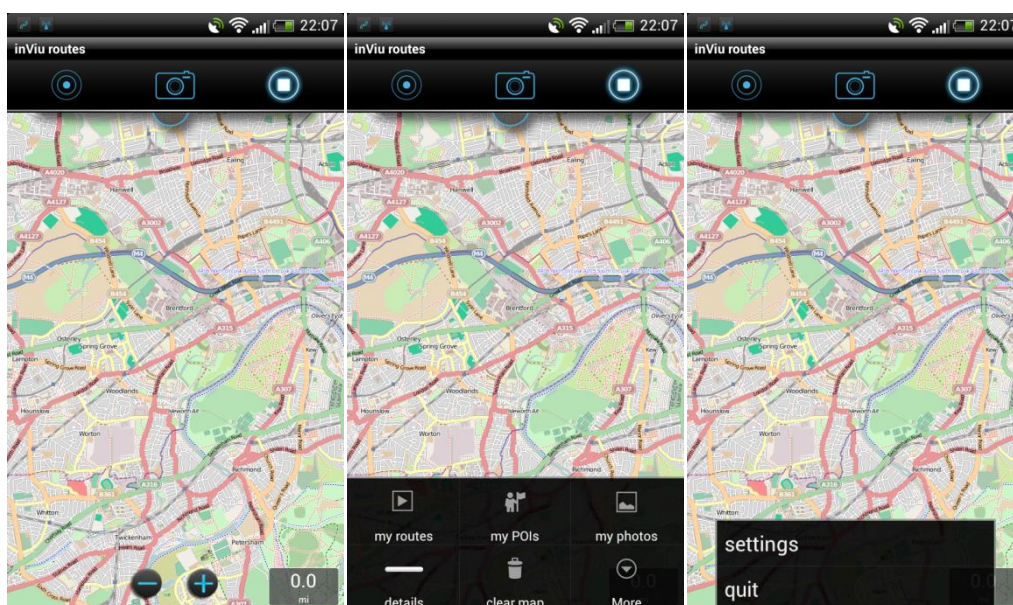
The *inViu routes* app can be used on any Android smartphone. If the app was not installed using Google Play, it is important to change the settings on the phone. Under "Security", the checkbox next to "Unknown sources" should be selected. Now the app is installed with the normal Android installation process.

3 Settings

Upon opening *inViu routes*, a map will appear in the first screen. With the GPS activated the device's position is displayed as a blue marker.

To reach the settings menu in *inViu routes*, click on:

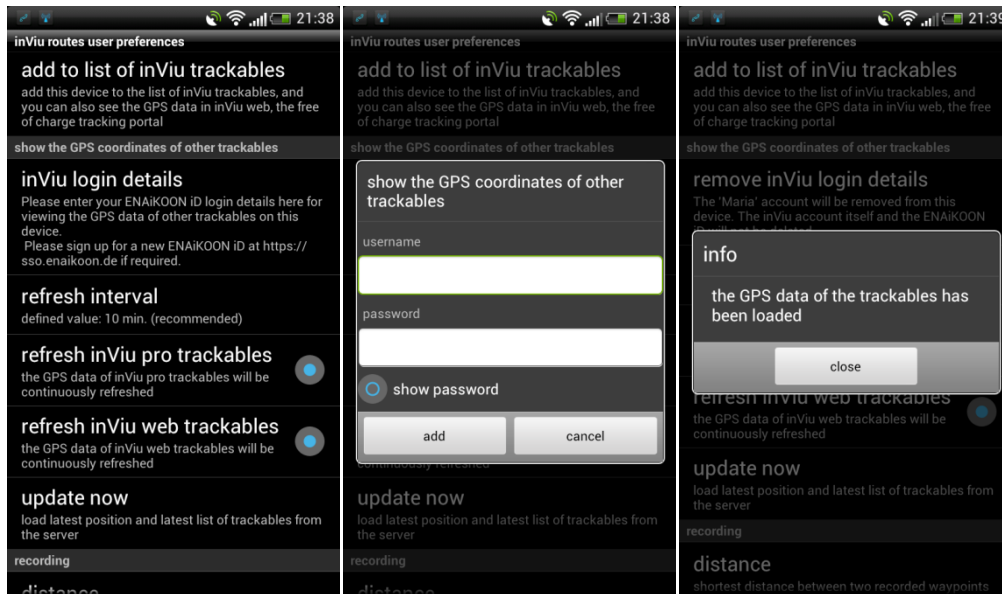
Android menu button → more → settings



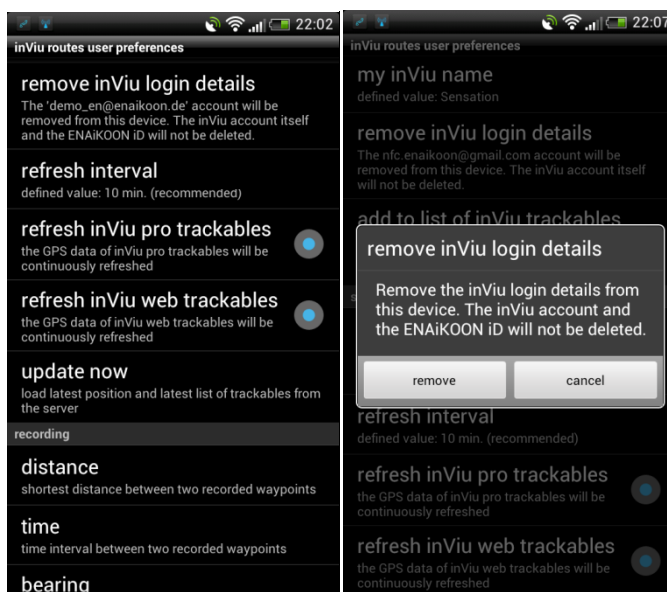
Scroll down in setting to find the option "show the GPS coordinates of other trackables".

4 Display the trackables associated with an ENAIKOON iD

Click on the option “inViu login details” and enter the login information (an E-mail address and password) for an ENAIKOON iD. An info window will pop up if the login was successful.



Click on “refresh interval” to change the refresh rate, which is how often the data is updated from the server. The shorter the interval the more recent the data is; however, more data traffic is produced. If both *inViu pro* and *inViu web* are registered in *inViu routes*, then the user can decide which online portal the trackables should be updated from. If a larger refresh interval is chosen, then the data can be updated manually by clicking on “update now”. With clicking on “remove inViu login details” the inViu account will be removed from the phone but not deleted.



5 Displaying the Trackable list

Once the login details for an ENAIKOON ID is entered, the user is able to see all trackables associated with the account. The button "trackables" will become available on the Android menu button *in inViu routes*.

Click on the button "trackables" and all of the trackables are displayed in a list.

The following information saved in *inViu pro* or *inViu web* is displayed:

- Trackable's name
- Drivers name
- Vehicle's license plate number
- Phone number

Additional information:

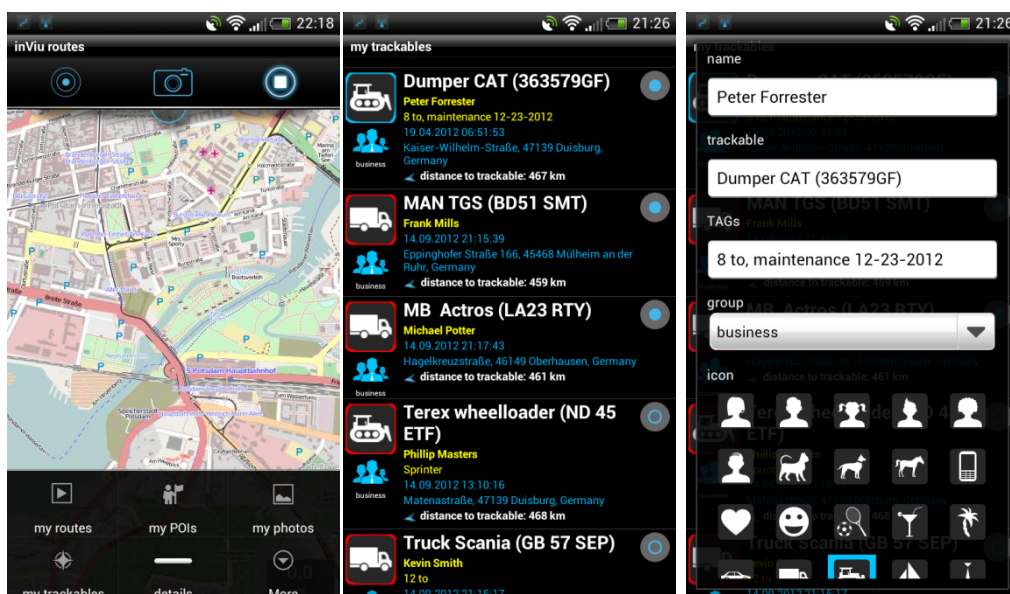
- Actual timestamp
- Actual address

Clicking on any trackable information will update the following:

- Icons
- Photos
- TAGs

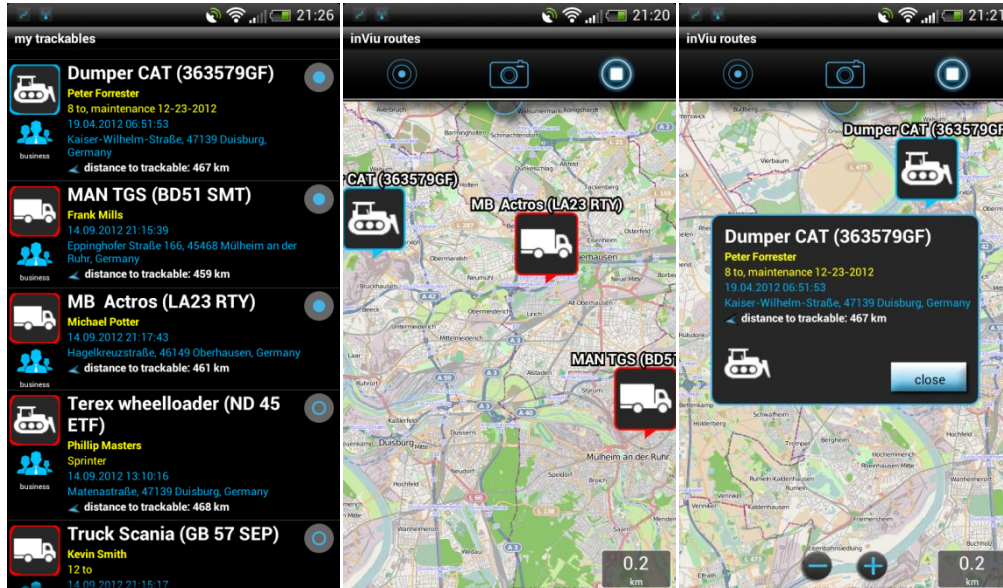
The coloured frame around the icon or the photo lets the user know if the ignition is currently on or off:

- Blue – ignition is on
- Red – ignition is off



6 Displaying the trackables on the map

In order to see a trackable's current position on the map, click on the checkbox next to the trackable in the trackables list. Use the phone's "back" button to return to the map. The updated locations of all selected trackables with the coloured frame will now be displayed on the map.



7 More options

To display more menu options, click on the "Android menu" button inside of the trackables list. In this menu, the user can adjust the following settings:

- Sort the trackable by
 - Trackable Name
 - Vehicle license plate
 - Driver name
 - Timestamp
 - Address
- Show all on map
- Clear all checkboxes
